

ANNOUNCEMENT

on the competition for the design sketches for 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament)

ANNOUNCED BY:

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THE PURPOSE OF THE COMPETITION:

By 2019, there will have been the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament). In the past in Georgia there were different types of legislative organizations. However, none of those organizations had never had perfect performance. The Georgian Constituent Assembly in 1919 was considered to be the first Parliament. Therefore, the National Bank of Georgia has decided to issue a collector coin in denomination of 5 Lari dedicated to this theme.

Applicants for the competition on selection of the design sketch for 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament), shall submit sketches in accordance with the terms and conditions attached hereafter.

TYPE OF THE COMPETITION:

Open competition

Any applicant may participate in the competition – both the individuals (resident/non-resident), as well as legal (resident/non-resident) entities, who meets the below criteria of the competition and presents sketch(es) of a design within the established terms, except for members of the temporary commission on “Defining themes and selection of design sketch/sketches of Lari bank notes and coins of collection purpose”, established under the order N°76/04, dated July 27, 2016, of the Governor of the National Bank of Georgia and employees of the National Bank of Georgia.

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Legal basis:

- ✓ Organic law of Georgia on “The National Bank of Georgia”.
- ✓ “Rule of production of Lari banknotes and coins” (articles 1-3), approved under Order N°5 of June 10, 2010 by the Board of the National Bank of Georgia.
- ✓ “Rule of procurement of production of Lari banknotes and coins” (articles 1-4), approved under Resolution N°5 of February 7, 2011, of the Board of the National Bank of Georgia.
- ✓ Resolution N°3, 30 January, 2018, by the Board of the National Bank of Georgia “on the Commencement of preparatory works for issuance of collector coins on the main theme taking place in 2019”.

- ✓ Protocol N°2, dated 19 February 2018 of the interim committee appointed for Defining themes and selection of design sketch/sketches of Lari banknotes and coins of collection purpose, under the order N°76/04 dated July 27, 2016, of the Governor of the National Bank of Georgia.

Terms and conditions of the Competition for the design sketch for 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament)

Article 1. Description of competition project:

Applicant is expected to consider the following requirements when preparing-presenting sketch/sketches of coin design:

1. Coin specifications: Denomination value – 5 Lari; Composition – silver; Diameter – 33 mm; edge – plain; quality – proof.
2. Main theme: Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament).
3. Purpose – for collection.
4. Requirements to artistic fulfilment:
 - 4.1. The design shall contain the following mandatory elements:
 - 4.1.1. Name of the currency in the Georgian and denominations value in figures – “5 ლარი”;
 - 4.1.2. Name of the issuer country in the Georgian and English languages – “საქართველო“, “Georgia”;
 - 4.1.3. Year of issue – “2019”;
 - 4.1.4. Lari symbol “ლ“;
 - 4.1.5. Detail(s)/writings pertaining to the main theme.
 - 4.2. The mentioned mandatory elements may be placed on the obverse and/or reverse of the coin as per choice of the applicant.
 - 4.3. Applicant may choose and use additional inscription(s), item(s), or detail(s) in the design, except for personal name (including that of the applicant), image, emblem, logo, brand sign or any other title or identifier of a commercial organization, subject to intellectual property;
 - 4.4. Other requirements to the content of the design:
 - 4.4.1. to correspond to the theme, purpose and specifications of the competition coin (*important*);
 - 4.4.2. to contain a colored detail (*optional*);
 - 4.4.3. to represent the own work (original) of the applicant, at the same time, in case of use of any other symbol and/or detail in the design, the applicant shall indicate the original source of such symbol and/or detail (*important*).
 - 4.4.4. Not be a copy or imitation (resembling) of designs of other coins (*important*).
5. Requirements to technical performance:

- 5.1. The sketch(es) for the competition shall be made in A4 format, both - in the presentation and the original size and it must be presented as a drawing/sketch (on a paper) in respect of the following rules and requirements:
 - 5.1.1. Applicant may use any type of shadow to express dimensions of the elements, which includes a form, a relief and a structure.
 - 5.1.2. Along with electronic file, used fronts and their titles shall be recorded on a provided electronic carrier.
- 5.2. Applicant shall present colored sketch/sketches.
6. The sketch(es) shall be attached with the coin design description text according to the requirements of the paragraph 4.4.3 of the present article and detailed and clear definition of the design content.
7. Applicant may present maximum of two different sketches.
8. Applicant shall present to the National Bank sketch(es), which are free from property or/and other kind of claims and obligations No other third person(s) shall have property, right or intellectual claims towards the sketch represented by applicant.

Article 2. Form and terms of presenting sketches for the competition to the National Bank:

1. Applicant shall present the competition material along with attached form (annex 1) of Statement. Statement shall contain personal data of an applicant (title of the competition, in case of an individual – full name, signature, address and telephone number of an applicant, in case of a legal entity – firm title, identification code, a representing person’s full name, signature, contact details) and agreement/consent to respect the conditions of the competition.
2. Applicant shall place separately, in two sealed envelopes, competition material and Statement, without indicating identity of an author/applicant. Competition design sketches shall be put in a big size envelope, definition and description text of the content of the design, while Statement shall be put in a smaller size envelope.
3. Both envelopes shall be put in one big envelope, which shall be sealed, indicating the address, addressee and title: **Tbilisi, 0114, Sanapiro street N°2, The National Bank of Georgia. “Design sketch for a 5 Lari collector coin, for competition”**.
4. Materials for the competition will be accepted within workdays from 21 February 2018 to 23 March 2018, from 10:00 a.m. to 18:00, at the address: 2 Sanapiro str, Tbilisi 0114, Georgia, The National Bank of Georgia.

Article 3. Terms and conditions for consideration of sketches submitted for the competition and awarding the winning sketch

1. Consideration of the sketches presented for the competition and identification of the winning sketch shall be completed no later than April 30, 2018.
2. Opening, consideration and evaluation of competition materials shall be done in a closed manner by the interim committee established under order N°76/04, dated July 27, 2016, of the Governor of the National Bank of Georgia for “Defining themes and selection of design sketch/sketches of

Lari banknotes and coins of collection purpose” (committee members will not be aware of the identity of applicants).

3. If requested by the committee, applicant(s) may be asked to present additional information. The mentioned information shall be presented to the committee not later than within 5 (five) working days from the date of request.
4. Sketches presented in violation of competition requirements and/or those presented after 18:00 of 23 March 2018, shall not be considered.
5. Selection-evaluation of the sketches shall be made in consideration of the following criteria:
 - 5.1. Idea;
 - 5.2. Compositional design (layout);
 - 5.3. Sketch performance quality.
6. The decision on the winning sketch shall be made by the Board of the National Bank of Georgia, based on the committee’s results of consideration of sketches.
7. The National Bank of Georgia reserves the right to disqualify applicant, if:
 - 7.1. Applicant violates or partially meets the conditions and rules of the competition;
 - 7.2. Applicant behaves dishonestly during competition or sketches’ selection procedures;
 - 7.3. Information presented by the applicant proves to be wrong/false.

Article 4. Amount of the prize established for the winning sketch and rule of its payment.

1. Money award in the amount of 3.000 (three thousand) Lari is established as a prize for the winning sketch (including all taxes envisaged under the legislation).
2. The author of the winning sketch (applicant) shall be paid the mentioned money award by wire transfer of the amount to his/her bank account within 10 (ten) workdays from signing of a contract (annex 2) with the applicant, once information about competition results are published on the web page of the National Bank of Georgia (www.nbg.gov.ge).

Article 5. Conditions of further disposal of sketch(es) presented for the competition

1. Presented sketches shall remain at the National Bank of Georgia.
2. The winning sketch shall become the property of the National Bank of Georgia upon the payment of the established award to the author. This implies, that:
 - 2.1. The National Bank of Georgia shall have the right to make further use and/or modify the sketch for the purposes of production of the coin and its popularization, without prior agreement with the applicant.
 - 2.2. The National Bank of Georgia shall be free from any claims and/or liabilities deriving from intellectual property, or any other copyright, neighboring rights or any other related rights (in case of existence of such), even in case if the winning sketch will be used and/or modified for the purpose of coin production and/or its popularization, by other entity, duly authorized by the National Bank of Georgia, who shall as well be free from the above mentioned claims and/or liabilities.

Article 6. Interrelations with the author of the winning sketch

After the competition is ended, upon request of the National Bank of Georgia, the winning applicant shall be obliged to participate in the process of improvement/development of design elements during production of 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament) and in case of the NBG's request shall be obliged to present the vector file of the design.

Article 7. Place and form of announcement of competition results

Information about competition results shall be published on web page of the National Bank of Georgia www.nbg.gov.ge within 5 (five) workdays from the adoption of a resolution on the approval of the winning sketch by the NBG Board.

Article 8. Other provisions

1. In case none of the sketches are presented within the terms indicated in the announcement of the competition, the competition shall be deemed as failed, while if none of the presented sketches are preferred and chosen for objective reasons, the competition shall be deemed finished with a negative result. Decision on announcement of a competition anew, or on the use of other means or methods for the same purpose, shall be made by the Board of the National Bank of Georgia.
2. In special occasions, cancellation of the announced competition shall be possible only upon a decision of the Board of the National Bank of Georgia. Information about cancellation of the announced competition shall be published no later than 5 (five) calendar days prior to the termination date of the acceptance of sketches for the competition, and in the same means of information, where the announcement on the conduct of the competition has been published.

I am aware and confirm hereby, that I shall be solely responsible for issues related with the right to use any symbol, detail, element, etc., in the design sketch presented to the National Bank of Georgia, as per acting legislation.

Besides that, I confirm, that sketch(es) presented by me are free from property or/and other kind of claims and obligations and in case of identification of such, I shall be deemed responsible according to acting legislation.

I confirm my agreement to modify the sketch or participate in the process of improvement/development of the design elements during the process of production of 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament), upon request of the National Bank of Georgia, if the sketch presented by me wins the competition.

CONTRACT

On the conditions of awarding the winner of the competition for the design sketch of 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament)

The National Bank of Georgia (hereinafter – the National Bank), represented by its executive director Mr. George Melashvili, address: N°2 Sanapiro str, Tbilisi 0114, Georgia, identification code: 203 824 148, on one contracting party, and _____ (born on XXXXXX, personal N° XXXXXX, address: Tbilisi XXXXX) (hereinafter – the Winner), on the other contracting party, agree on the following:

Article 1. Subject of the Contract

1. The subject of the contract shall be awarding a prize to the winner of the **competition for selection of the design sketch** 5 Lari denomination collector coin dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Georgian Constituent Assembly (Parliament) (hereinafter – the sketch), and upon request of the National Bank, participation of the winner in the process of improvement/development of the sketch, as per the conditions of the present contract.

Article 2. Rights and Obligations of the Parties

1. The National Bank shall pay the winner 3.000 (three thousand) GEL as a prize for winning the competition. The mentioned amount includes all taxes established in accordance with Georgian legislation.
2. The payment of the amount shall be made within 10 (ten) workdays from the date of signature of the present contract, by means of transfer to the bank account of the winner – GE XXXXXXX.
3. The National Bank shall be authorized to make any further use of the sketch and/or its modification without prior agreement with the winner, for the purpose of coin production and/or its popularization.
4. The National Bank shall be free from any claims and/or liabilities deriving from intellectual property, or any other copyright, and any other related rights (in case of existence of such), even in case if the winning sketch will be used and/or modified for the purpose of coin minting and/or its popularization, by duly authorized representatives of the National Bank, who shall as well be free from the above mentioned claims and/or liabilities.
5. The winner, by signing the present contract, in relation to the presented sketch, shall:
 - a. Disclaims in favor of the National Bank any copyright, related and property rights, in case of existence of such, as well as any other rights or requests deriving from these rights;
 - b. Disclaims the right that his/her name, as the author of the sketch, is indicated on each reviewed copy of the sketch or when published in any possible way;
 - c. Agrees that his/her name and family name, is used by the National Bank in relation to the winning sketch in its public statements, addresses, web page or information circulated by printed means, TV or radio announcements, as well as in case of dissemination of the sample in any form, as per consideration of the National Bank.
6. By signing the present contract, the winner shall confirm that she/he does not have and/or may not have any kind of claim whatsoever, deriving from legislation or contractual relations, towards the

National Bank, in relation with the use and/or modification of the sketch, presented by the winner under the conditions of the competition even in case if this sketch will be used and/or modified for the purpose of coin production and its popularization, by the National Bank of Georgia and/or by other entity duly authorized by the National Bank, who shall as well be free from the above mentioned claims and/or liabilities.

7. According to the “Law of Georgia on Copyright and Neighboring Rights”, the National Bank shall be the owner of copyright and property rights for any object, created based on modifications performed by the National Bank to the sketch and the winner shall not be authorized to claim a right to the National Bank in relation to the object created by the latest.
8. The winner confirms that she/he shall be solely responsible as per acting legislation, for issues related with the right to use any symbol, detail, element, etc., in the sketch presented to the National Bank.
9. By signing the present contract, the winner confirms, that sketch(es) presented by him/her are free from property or/and other kind of claims and obligations and in case of identification of such, the winner shall be deemed responsible according to acting legislations.
10. The winner shall be obliged to:
 - a. Participate, upon request of the National Bank, in the process of improvement/development of the sketch and perform relevant tasks accordingly;
 - b. Upon request, hand over to the National Bank, all materials related to the sketch, both in hard and electronic forms (including vector file(s) of the sketch);
 - c. Upon request, hand over to the National Bank information and documents needed for processing of the sketch.
11. Obligations related with intellectual property rights, as provided for by the present article for the parties, shall remain valid after termination of the present contract.
12. In case of violation of terms and conditions of the present contract, or in case of undue fulfilment of his/her obligations, the National Bank shall be authorized to suspend relations with the winner and request from him/her compensation of any damage caused by non-fulfilment or undue fulfillment of his/her obligations.

Article 3. Other Provisions

1. The present contract is established in accordance with the legislation of Georgia. The Parties shall settle any dispute arising from fulfilment of the present contract by means of mutual agreement and consultations, otherwise the Parties may address the court.
2. Any dispute that cannot be resolved by negotiation shall be resolved pursuant to the laws of Georgia in the courts of Georgia.
3. Any amendments or changes to the contract shall be made upon written agreement of the Parties, which shall be deemed as integral part of the contract.
4. The contract is made in Georgian and English languages, in three originals of equal legal power, out of which two copies shall be handed over to the National Bank, while one copy shall be handed over to the winner. In a case of resistance between the Georgian and English versions of the contract, provisions of the Georgian version should prevail.
5. The contract shall be made valid on the date of its signing by the Parties.
